Popularly known as the Wooden Wonder due to its all-wood construction, the Mosquito in its numerous versions was one of the most successful British aircraft in the Second World War. It made headlines throughout the major part of the conflict and can claim to have been the fastest aircraft in RAF Bomber Command from 1942 until the arrival of the Canberra nine years later. As a fighter, the Mosquito excelled. It undertook low-level strikes across Europe, became the Allies top night-fighter and, with Coastal Command, fought the sea war as an anti-shipping strike. This new "Forty-Eighth" scale kit of the famous F.B.VI fighter version has optional armament and markings enabling a Fighter or Coastal Command aircraft to be built. Precise in detail and including a full cockpit layout, this model forms a fitting tribute to this superb design.



# AIRCRAFT

## 48th SCALE SERIES 4



### SUPERMARINE SPITFIRE VB

Probably the greatest fighter aircraft of all time, the Spitfire established a reputation in the Battle of Britain that carried through the war years and has survived to this day. Designed by a team headed by R. J. Mitchell, the prototype Spitfire made its first flight in March 1936, and in all a total of 22,758 aircraft were built. It is fitting that a kit of this

famous aircraft be included early in this new 1:48th scale series, and even more so, when the model chosen is that of a Mk. VB, one of the largest production variants. Full cockpit detail is provided in this 63-part kit and optional items and markings enable one of two versions to be built, a European-based aircraft or a tropical Spitfire VB flown by one of Britain's most famous fighter pilots.



### MESSERSCHMITT BF 109F

Top fighter of the German Luftwaffe, the Bf 109 established itself as one of the major combat aircraft of the Second World War, fighting as did from 1938 until the final collapse in 1945. The F version began replacing the Bf 109E in squadron service in 1941 and proved itself to be a much refined aircraft with a greater combat performance than

out-matched the RAF's early Spitfires. It was issued to Luftwaffe units throughout Europe and the Mediterranean, being flown by some of the German air force's greatest aces. Optional parts and markings in this kit enable either a North European-based aircraft to be modelled or an aircraft flown in North Africa. More than 55 parts are provided in this detailed kit.

### HAWKER SIDDELEY HARRIER GR.1 18001-4

A highly detailed and advanced kit in the 1:24th scale range, this model of one of the world's most technically advanced warplanes does full justice to the type's versatility as a vertical take-off and landing combat aircraft. Moveable control surfaces, a retractable undercarriage, a cockpit sealed down from the real thing, a fully detailed and accessible Peppasus engine, and optional underwing weapons - all these and more are outstanding features of this kit which has more than 280 parts. Two sets of markings are included, one for an RAF aircraft of the famous No. 1 Squadron and the other for a US Marine Corps aircraft - designated by that service as AV-8A.



### JUNKERS Ju 87B STUKA 18002-7

One of the most effective dive-bombers of the Second World War, the Ju 87 Stuka played a major role in Germany's conquest of Europe and contributed significantly to the campaigns in North Africa and Russia. **NORTH AMERICAN P-51D MUSTANG 14001-2**  
One of the finest single-engined fighters of all time, the Mustang claimed the distinction in the Second World War of being the first single-engined combat plane based in Britain, to reach Berlin. This kit, containing over 200 parts, will build a P-51D version and includes a detailed Packard Merlin engine, cockpit layout with sliding canopy and retractable undercarriage. Armament consists of underwing bombs, rockets and six 0.5-in. machine guns, three in each wing, with removable access panels. The kit contains a choice of transfer markings for two American Eighth Air Force Mustangs. As in other 'Superkits', the propeller may be motorised.



**HAWKER HURRICANE MK. I**

This 'Superkit' of Hawker's famous Hurricane eight-gun fighter captures well Sydney Camm's rugged design which fought with such distinction in the Battle of Britain. There are over 200 parts in this kit and items of particular note include the exceptionally detailed cockpit with readable instruments, the two four-gun wing bays with their ammunition boxes and feeds, the replaceable G.303-in. Browning machine-guns and the finely detailed Merlin engine with removable access panels. Optional markings are provided for two Hurricanes flown by Battle of Britain ace: Squadron Leader Peter Townend's aircraft and Flt Lt Ian Gleeds.



**MESSERSCHMITT Bf 109G-6**

Best known of all German fighters, the version represented here was introduced in 1942 and includes optional armament and transfer markings.

**SUPERMARINE SPITFIRE IX**

The most famous fighter of the Second World War, provided here in the markings of British ace Johnson, DSO, DFC.



**GLOSTER GLADIATOR**

The last RAF fighter to have a totally enclosed cockpit, the Gladiator fought in France, Norway and Greece and gained lasting distinction during the defence of Malta. Colourful pre-war markings are included in the kit.

**FOKKER DR.I TRIPANE**

Germany's most famous fighter in the First World War and the machine flown by her greatest aces, including Baron Von Richthofen.

**JUNKERS Ju 87B**

The infamous 'Stuka' was a major weapon of the Luftwaffe at the beginning of the war but proved too vulnerable to use in the face of determined fighter opposition.



**HAWKER HURRICANE IV R.P.**

Torpedoed with the Spitfire, the Hurricane shared honours in the Battle of Britain for fighter work. This is a fast version complete with rocket armament.

Affectionately remembered by Second World War airmen as the type in which they made their initial flights, the Tiger Moth is still flying in many parts of the world.

NORTH AMERICAN P-51D MUSTANG 01018-1  
One of the finest piston-engined fighters of the Second World War. This is of an early D version, has American 8th AF Force markings.



FOCKE-WULF Fw 190D

Long-nose version of the classic German fighter of the Second World War, complete with bomb for its fighter-bomber role.



DOUGLAS A-4D-1 SKYHAWK

01022-3

One of the smallest carrier-based aircraft, built the 700 mph. Skyhawk is capable of carrying an atomic bomb.



GRUMMAN GOSLING

01024-9

A twin-engined amphibian, the Goshawk served with the Royal Navy in the Second World War on communications duties. It was also flown by the US Coast Guard under the name Widgeon.



ARMSTRONG WHITWORTH  
SEAHAWK

01025-2

A most efficient carrier-borne fighter-bomber, the Seahawk kit can be built as either a German or Royal Navy version.



FIAT G.91R-1

01026-6

This light reconnaissance fighter operated chiefly with the West German and Italian air forces within NATO. It was designed to fly from unprepared forward airfields in a tactical role.



HAWKER TYPHOON

01027-2

Known as the 'Tank Buster' the Typhoon specialised in attacking ground targets and played an important part in the liberation of Europe.



MITSUBISHI A6M2 ZERO

01028-1

Celebrated Japanese warbird aircraft. Used as a fighter, trainer, dive-bomber and eventually as a suicide plane.



JET PROVOST MK. 3

01029-4

Still in widespread service with RAF units, the Jet Provost pioneered side-by-side training. This kit includes container rocket armament for the weapon training role.



MESSERSCHMITT ME 262A

01030-4

The world's first turbojet to be used operationally in the fighter-bomber role, the Me 262 marked the peak of German aircraft design in the Second World War.



BOULTON PAUL DEFIANT N.F.1

01031-7

The rotating turret and elevating guns of the full-size aircraft are faithfully reproduced in this kit of the famous night-fighter. Markings for a 250 Squadron Defiant are supplied.



# AIRCRAFT

## 72nd SCALE SERIES 1

**YAK-9D**

Probably the most famous of Soviet Second World War fighters, the Yak was a simple but extremely efficient machine.

**HAWEK SIDDELEY GNAT**

Famous as the aircraft flown by the RAF's aerobatic team, the Red Arrows, the Gnat is the Service's standard advanced trainer. Markings for the whole team are included.

**GRUMMAN WILDCAT**

The sturdy and reliable Wildcat served with the US Navy and the Fleet Air Arm and transfers for both are included in the kit.

**CURTISS P-40 KITTYHAWK**

The last Kittyhawks to go into action were used by the RAF in the Western Desert and this model includes the colourful Shrike's 10th intake of 112 Squadron RAF.

**BELL P-39 AIRACOBRA**

The单座的P-39 had its engine mounted behind the pilot and had a tricycle undercarriage. Supplied with American and Russian markings.

**COMMONWEALTH CA-13 BOOMERANG**

This, the first Australian fighter, was a basic Second World War design, built and flown in a number of models. Transfers are included for both 4 and 5 Squadrons RAAF.

**WESTLAND SCOUT**

The standard general purpose helicopter with the British Army, this superbly detailed kit is provided with British and Jordanian transfers.

**NORTHROP F-5A FREEDOM FIGHTER**

Designed specifically for use by the smaller air forces of the West, Iranian Air Force markings are included with this kit together with a selection of underwing stores.

**FIAT G.50BIS**

Although under-powered and out-gunned by allied fighters, the G.50 served with the Italian Air Force until the end of the Second World War.

**FEISELER STORCH**

Best known of all German observation and liaison aircraft, the Storch was the personal transport of top German generals. Optional markings are included in the kit.

**AVRO 504K**

Considered by many to be the RAF's greatest biplane, the Avro 504 was built in numbers exceeding 9,000. This detailed kit depicts the First World War K version.

**SPAD VII**

The diminutive Spad was used by French, British and American units in the First World War. This model is in the markings of one of the great French aces, Lt Guynemer.



**HANNOVER CL. III** 01060-8  
A two-seater fighter which was also used for ground attack, the Hannover CL. III was fitted with a Hispano tail to give the rear gunner a wide field of fire. A total of 31 parts is included.



**HAWKER DEMON** 01062-4  
An extremely colourful fighter from the pre-war era, the Demon was a development of the famous Horn bomber biplane.



**CESSNA O-2** 01063-7  
This unusual 'push-pull' twin is a development of the Cessna Super Skymaster and is operated by the USAF on forward air control and observation duties. Under-wing weapon loads are provided with this kit.



**de HAVILLAND CHIPMUNK** 01064-0  
Designed as a successor to the famous Tiger Moth and first produced in Canada in 1946, the Chipmunk was adopted as the standard basic trainer by the RAF and is still in widespread use today.



**SCOTTISH AVIATION BULLDOG** 01065-5  
A development of the earlier Beagle Pup, the Bulldog two-seat basic trainer has been ordered in quantity for the RAF as a Chipmunk replacement. A considerable number have been exported to many overseas air forces and this kit has Swedish as well as RAF markings.



**CESSNA BIRD DOG** 01066-2  
The light observation aircraft best known in Korea and more recently operated in a forward air control role in Vietnam. A choice of markings is included.



**WESTLAND WHIRLWIND** 01019-7  
Low level anti-shipping and train-busting sorties were the speciality of the RAF Whirlwind squadrons. This completely new kit combines all the main features of this formidable aircraft, and includes two sets of markings.



# AIRCRAFT

## 72nd SCALE SERIES 1

**SA.341 GAZELLE**

This revolutionary helicopter employs the unique 'rotor in the tail' concept which is faithfully depicted in this over 40-part kit. Transfers for an Army aircraft are included.

**PIPER CHEROKEE ARROW II**


An extension of the popular Cherokee range of light aircraft, the Arrow is a more powerful version currently in world-wide use. A high degree of detail is incorporated in the kit and there are optional transfers.

**BRISTOL BULLDOG**

The most famous of the inter-war fighters, a total of 212 was supplied to eleven RAF squadrons. Markings are supplied for all aircraft of 19 Squadron.

**SOPWITH PUP**

Renowned as one of the finest single-seat fighter scouts of the First World War, the Pup was a true pilot's aeroplane having finely balanced controls and a high degree of manoeuvrability. The highly detailed kit has markings for both an RFC and RNAS machine.

**Me 163B KOMET**

Germany's fastest fighter in the Second World War by virtue of its rocket motor, the remarkable Komet achieved considerable success against daylight bombers during the last months of the war. This new kit has 28 parts and two sets of markings.

# FAIRCHILD

## SERIES 2



**LOCKHEED P-38J LIGHTNING** 02004-8  
This kit builds the later version of this famous twin-engine fighter. The markings depict a European-based 8th Air Force Lightning.



**FAIREY SWORDFISH II** 02005-1  
A biplane widely known as the 'Stringbag', the Swordfish was already obsolete at the beginning of the Second World War, but remained in service until 1945. Complete with both rocket and torpedo armament.



**BRISTOL BEAUFIGHTER T.F.X.** 02003-5  
Initially a night-fighter, later Beaufighter variants were used for torpedo bombing and as long-range fighters. This model is of a torpedo-carrying Mark X. Underwing rockets are also included.



**MESSERSCHMITT ME 110D** 02006-4  
When operated during the Battle of Britain as a long-range heavy fighter the Me 110 was outclassed by the British fighters. It was later to fly successfully in the night-fighter role over Germany.



**H.D.L HOVERCRAFT SR.N1** 02007-7  
The SR.N1 was the first practical hovercraft and was built to prove the air cushion principle developed by C.S. Cockerell. This kit has 46 parts.



**HAWEK HUNTER F.6** 02008-0  
This kit of the famous Hunter - a biplane in widespread service with foreign air forces and the RAF - features a removable gun pack and underwing rocket armament. Markings are supplied for an RAF aircraft of 111 Squadron 'Black Arrows', and a Swiss AF machine.



**AVRO ANSON I** 02009-2  
This type has one of the longest service careers of any aircraft, flying with the RAF for more than twenty years. Transfers are provided for an RAF Coastal Command Anson flown by an all-Dutch crew.



**B.A.C. E.F. LIGHTNING** 02010-3  
The first British combat aircraft with supersonic performance, the Lightning is the main interceptor of RAF Strike Command. This kit contains missile armament and transfers for 741 Squadron.



**LOCKHEED F-104G STARFIGHTER** 02011-0  
Standard fighter-bomber with many NATO and Western air forces, this F-104G kit includes West German and Canadian transfers.



# AIRCRAFT

## 72nd SCALE SERIES 2



**DASSAULT MIRAGE IIIC** 02012-3  
Combat-service with the Israeli Air Force in the 1967 and 1973 Middle East wars, this supersonic French delta-wing fighter is operational with many air forces. Rockets and missiles are included in the kit which has 38 parts.



**VERTOL 107-1** 02015-3  
Produced in both military and civil versions, the Vertol 107 is currently in world-wide service. This detailed kit has 94 parts, including some operating features and has Swedish Navy markings.



**FAIREY FIREFLY** 02016-7  
The best of the British-designed Fleet Air Arm fighters, the Firefly entered service in 1942 and was made continued in use until 1956. The Swedish-operated in Korea and markings are provided for an aircraft of the period.



**GRUMMAN F6F HELLCAT** 02023-8  
An outstanding Naval fighter of the Second World War, the Hellcat served mainly in the Pacific. This kit includes USN and Royal Navy transfers.



**DOUGLAS DAUNTLESS** 02022-6  
The carrier-based Dauntless was the most effective of the wartime US Navy dive-bombers. The kit has optional parts for producing any one of the main variants.



**VOUGHT KINGFISHER** 02021-5  
Built in both landplane and floatplane versions and operated by the US services and the Royal Navy, this kit includes optional landing gear and transfers for both pre-war and wartime machines.



**ARADO Ar 196** 02019-0  
This biplane fighter and light bomber was carried on German battleships and also saw extensive service on shore-based coastal patrol duties.



**BRISTOL BLENHEIM IV** 02027-1  
An outstanding aircraft of the Second World War, the Blenheim operated as a bomber and a fighter. Both versions can be modelled from the kit which includes Free French transfers.



**MIG-21** 02024-0  
One of the standard versions of this outstanding Russian fighter. The MiG-21 is displayed in the colours of many communist countries, and in the Middle East.



**HENSCHEL Hs 129** 02032-3  
Used mainly on the Russian front, the Hs 129 was extremely effective in the close-support role. This 64-part kit builds either the B2 bomber version or the B3 tank-busting aircraft equipped with the long 75mm gun.



**CURTISS SB2C HELLDIVER** 02001-0  
Both the SB2C-4 and -5 versions can be made from this kit of the US carrier-based dive-bomber which played an important part in the defeat of Japan. Optional transfers and armament are provided in this 77-part kit.



**DOUGLAS A-1J SKYRAIDER** 02030-0  
A very fine attack aircraft which achieved an outstanding combat record during the Vietnam war. Optional markings for two US Navy machines are included together with a large underwing weapon load.

**BRITTEN-NORMAN DEFENDER**

Revised and updated, this kit of the military Defender also has parts enabling an Islander of Air Liberia to be built. Defenders are used in a number of roles including anti-smuggling and light attack.

**MOSQUITO FB VI**

02001-9

**FAIREY BATTLE**

This large single-engined light bomber was standard equipment with the RAF in 1939. High losses at the beginning of the war led to its withdrawal and re-introduction as a trainer and target tug. RAF and Belgian markings are provided.

**DOUGLAS TBD-1 DEVASTATOR**

When the USA entered the war, the Devastator was the standard US Navy torpedo-bomber and suffered considerable losses in the early Pacific battles. Colourful pre-war finishes are included.

**NORTH AMERICAN OV-10A BRONCO**

Now in USAF and US Marine service and one of the most versatile combat aircraft ever built, the Bronco is designed to carry out a wide variety of roles in counter-insurgency and limited war operations. A variety of external loads is provided as are optional transitors.

**HAWKER SIDDELEY HARRIER**

The vertical take-off Harrier is developed from the P.1127. The kit contains a selection of armament loads and can be assembled with the undercarriage retracted or lowered.

**FOCKE-WULF Fw 189**

The most important of the Luftwaffe's reconnaissance machines in the Second World War, the Fw 189 was used mainly on the Russian front. It was a rugged aircraft capable of operating under the worst conditions and of absorbing enormous punishment.

**GLOSTER METEOR III**

The only Allied jet to see service in the Second World War, the Meteor III was used against the V-1 Flying Bombs. Later versions operated in the Korean war and served with the RAF until the 1960s.

### FOUGA MAGISTER

Famous as the aircraft flown by the French national aerobatic team Patrouille de France, the Magister forms the main jet trainer component of a number of air forces. A comprehensive transfer sheet provides insignia for German, Belgian and French-operated Magisters.

### SAAB DRAKEN

Standard equipment with the Royal Swedish Air Force, the Draken fighter and reconnaissance aircraft is also operated by the Danish and Finnish air forces. Underwing racks can carry a wide variety of weapons.

### LOCKHEED F-80C SHOOTING STAR

The first American jet to be built in any numbers, this famous ground-attack aircraft was the mainstay of Allied effort during the Korean War. This 54-part kit includes markings for two aircraft of the period.

### B.A.C. STRIKEMASTER

This combined kit has parts to build either a Strikemaster ground-attack aircraft or its trainer counterpart, the jet Provost Mk. 5. The former has underslung weapons and military markings while the latter has RAF Red Arrow aerobatic team transfers.

### NORTH AMERICAN P-51D MUSTANG

The sleek Mustang with its high performance was one of the outstanding fighter-bombers of the Second World War. This 62-part kit has optional weapon loads and parts to build either a P-51D or a P-51K. Markings are provided for a USAAF or RAAF machine.

### SUPERMARINE SPITFIRE VB

More Spitfire VB were built than any other variant of this most famous of all fighter aircraft. This version carried the aircraft to Europe after the Battle of Britain. The kit includes transfers for an American-operated Spitfire and an aircraft of a Polish squadron.

### MESSERSCHMITT BF 109

The "E" version of the famous Bf 109 German fighter fought initially during the Spanish Civil War and then flew against the RAF in the Battle of Britain in 1940. This 42-part kit provides optional bomb loads and sets of authentic markings.

**BREWSTER BUFFALO**

This 44-piece kit has transfers and parts enabling either the American or British version to be built. The Buffalo was easily recognisable by its short boom-shaped fuselage.

**HENSCHEL Hs 123A-1**

Combat-proven in the Spanish Civil War, the Hs 123 operated as both a dive-bomber and as a ground-attack aircraft in the French and Russian campaigns. Spanish and German transfers are included in the kit.

**WESTLAND LYASANDER**

Initially used in the Army Co-operation role, the Lysander gained fame as a spy transport. Markings for two versions are provided.

**VOUGHT F4U-1D CORSAIR**

Immediately recognisable by its inverted-gull wings, the Corsair of the US Navy performed brilliantly against the Japanese in the Pacific, where it was known as the Whispering Death. US Marine Corps and USAF markings are provided.

**REPUBLIC P-47D THUNDERBOLT**

An extremely efficient German aircraft progressively developed throughout the Second World War. This 51-part kit includes parts for either level or dive-bomber versions.

**BLACKBURN WA.39 BUCCANEER**

03004-1

An important current strike aircraft in service with the Royal Navy and with the South African Air Force. This model has such operating features as a rotating bomb bay, folding nose cone and wings and optional disc-brakes.

**DOUGLAS BOSTON III**

03005-4

An important day bomber used widely by Allied tactical units, the Boston replaced the Bischam from 1941 and served with considerable success in Europe, the Middle East and Russia. Sixty-five parts are included in the kit which has markings for 88 Squadron RCAF.

**LOCKHEED HUDSON I**

03006-7

One of the first types to be bought by the RAF in the Second World War, the Hudson gained fame as a long-range Coastal Command reconnaissance bomber. This model has a retracting undercarriage, rotating turret and moveable control surfaces.

**JUNKERS Ju 88A-4**

03007-7

The Ju 88 was the most versatile of all German bombers. A superbly detailed model can be made from the 127-piece kit which includes full armament and engine.

**de HAVILLAND MOSQUITO**

03019-3

Nicknamed 'the Wooden Wonder' the Mosquito was one of the Second World War's most versatile aircraft. XVIII anti-shipping aircraft with a 57mm gun.

**SH-3D SEA KING**

The Sikorsky Sea King helicopter operates with the US Navy and with the Royal Navy. Sonar equipment, torpedoes and depth charges are all included in this highly-detailed kit.

**B.A.C. JAGUAR GR.1**

This popular kit has now been completely revised and updated to depict the half-production Jaguar GR.1 supersonic strike aircraft now in service with the RAF. Squadron markings and a wide choice of weapons give the model the versatility of the real aircraft.

**HANLEY PAGE JETSTREAM**

**LING-TEMCO-VOUGHT A-7D/C CORSAIR II**

This potent ground-attack jet carries a formidable array of underline weapons and is currently in service with the USAF (A-7D) and the US Navy (A-7E). Markings for both these versions are included in this 81-part kit.

**D.H.C. BEAVER**

Designed primarily for duties in the far north of Canada where it is used for passenger and freight work, the Beaver is in widespread use with many air forces. Optional transfers are provided for a US Army and British Army aircraft. Skis, floats and wheels are included in this 34-part kit.

**LOCKHEED P-38 LIGHTNING**

One of the more distinctive aircraft operated during the Second World War, the twin-boom Lightning saw action with the USAAF in all the major war areas. This kit is of the F version with European and Pacific theatre markings.



One of the most famous transport aircraft of the Second World War, the Ju 52 was an integral part of the German war machine and operated on every front. 

**GRUMMAN F-14A TOMCAT**

**HEINKEL He 177**

The He 177 Greif was one of Germany's most ambitious wartime bombers. It operated against targets in the UK and Russia, while anti-shipping versions employed early missiles against convoys in the Atlantic. 160 parts are contained in this kit which includes rocket-propelled anti-shipping missiles.

## SERIES 6, 7 & 9



**SHORT SUNDERLAND III** 06001-1  
Famous for its long-range reconnaissance flights in the Second World War, the Sunderland, suitably earned the nickname "Flying Porcupine" from its armament due to its heavy defensive armament, it went into service in the Berlin Airlift and the Korean War. This impressive model constructed with 160 parts has the now-vintage bomb racks which are movable, full bracing gear, and working gun turrets and control surfaces.



**SHORT STIRLING** 06002-4  
The angular Stirling completes the trio of wartime British heavies: it was the first four-engined bomber to come into RAF service in the Second World War and took part in the famous attacks on the Schleissheim and Gelsenkirchen. When replaced as a night-bomber, it continued in use for mine-laying, transport and as a glider tug. No less than 273 parts are contained in this remarkable kit which can be built up into either a B.I or B.III version. The enormous undercarriage is faithfully detailed. In all its detail, the bomb bays can be assembled either open to display the full bomb load and an RAF trailer and bomb carts are also included.



**BOEING B-29 SUPERFORTRESS** 07001-4  
Known as the "Bomber that won the war", the B-29 was the largest and heaviest bomber to see service and was responsible for the victory over Japan. Active research in co-operation with the Boeing Company and the American Aviation Historical Society has brought about one of the most impressive and accurate models to date. This fabulous kit has over 200 parts including the remotely controlled guns of the tail-end aircraft and operating bomb doors revealing a full load of bombs. Retractable undercarriage and movable control surfaces are, of course, included and the optional transfers supplied give a choice of two of the most famous Superfortresses: "Jolly Jock" operating from the South Pacific and "Candy Apple" which flew from China.



**LOCKHEED C-130 HERCULES** 09001-0  
Since 1956, when deliveries began, the Hercules has become the most widely used military transport aircraft in the world. It is capable of operating from unprepared strips in remote areas and can carry up to 64 paratroops or 92 combat-equipped troops. This giant model is impressive in both size and detail; it has a wingspan of 22m., a working rear loading ramp, movable control surfaces, and optional parts and markings enabling the modeller to build one of two versions, a C-130E of the USAF or a Hercules C.Mk. 1 of RAF Strike Command.





Designed by the Americans and used by them in the Pacific, the Buffalo was used by the British in north-west Europe for amphibious operations in the Second World War. Over 100 parts make a detailed model complete with Jeep cargo.

The Bloodhound remains the RAF's standard ground-to-air missile and a number of other countries use it for anti-aircraft defence. The kit includes launching platform, wheeled trailer, Land Rover and six figures.



### 25-POUNDER FIELD GUN

Used throughout the Second World War and afterwards in Malaya and Korea, the 25-pounder was considered one of the finest field guns ever produced. It has only recently been retired from British Army service. Kit is complete with the Morris cab, limber and crew.

A further addition to the popular R&P equipment sets, this double consists of the well-known "Queen Mary" trailer with a Bedford tractor unit and a Dafco crane on a Thermoflame Aeronav chassis. 






### SERIES 5

#### SS 'CANBERRA'

06201-6

The largest turbo-electric passenger liner ever built in Britain, Canberra has been described as 'the ship that shapes the future'. Aluminium was used extensively in her construction and her modern lines are without doubt far in advance of many other passenger ships. The completed model is 16½in. long and transfers are included for all the dark gunmetal areas.

#### RMS 'MAURETANIA'

For twenty-two years this was the fastest North Atlantic liner. During the First World War she served as an armed cruiser and then as a hospital ship. This kit contains 139 parts and is 15½in. long.

#### RMS 'QUEEN ELIZABETH'

Her maiden voyage in March 1930 was a well-kept secret and she served the war years as a troop ship. Completely refurbished she was virtually a new ship when she made her first commercial voyage in 1946. The 131 parts of this magnificent kit build up into an impressive and highly detailed model.

#### 'QUEEN ELIZABETH 2'

The latest Cunard liner and the world's most modern luxury vessel, the Queen Elizabeth 2 was launched at Clydebank in September 1967. Almost 150 pieces are included in this superb kit which builds up into an authentic 16½in. long model.

#### SS 'FRANCE'

06202-2

The 65,000-ton France, pride of the French line prior to her retirement in 1979, is the world's longest liner. She sailed on her maiden voyage to New York on 3rd February 1962. She carried 2,000 passengers and had a crew of 1,000. Consisting of no less than 148 parts, this kit builds a really authentic 20½in. long model.

## SERIES 1

**HMS 'COSSACK'** 01202-7  
Cossack was the best known of the famous Tribal class destroyers, having an impressive war-time record. She is best remembered for the audacious raid on the German battleship *Bismarck*, and for the action against the *Elmendorf*.



**HMS 'DARING'** 01203-0  
Launched in 1959 and completed in 1962, HMS Daring was a powerful ship, having radar and much improved armament over the wartime destroyers she was to replace.



**HMS 'HOTSPUR'** 01205-6  
This was one of the famous 'Hotspur' class destroyers and played a leading part in the earliest naval action of the Second World War. Hotspur survived to take part in the D-Day landings.



**HMS 'CAMPBELTOWN'** 01204-3  
Remembered as the ship which took part in the famous raid on St Nazaire in 1942. Campbeltown was one of 144 American destroyers transferred to the Royal Navy in the Second World War.



**HMS 'LEANDER'** 01206-9  
The 'Leander' class of general purpose frigates is the largest in the Royal Navy at this time. Each one carries a helicopter and the most modern anti-submarine and anti-aircraft weapons.

## SERIES 2



**'ROMMEL'** 02202-0  
The largest destroyer to join the German Navy is almost as large as a warship cruiser. Built in the USA it has a full range of guided missiles and advanced electronics.



**HMS 'AMAZON'** 02204-6  
A Type 21 frigate, Amazon was launched in 1972. She is the first warship to be designed by commercial firms and custom-built for many years. Weaponry includes Soviet missiles, Squid anti-submarine mortars and a helicopter.



**HMS 'MANXMAN'** 02200-3  
One of the fastest ships ever to serve in the Royal Navy, Manxman was a high-speed minesweeper that became famous transporting troops and stores to Malta.



**NARVIK CLASS DESTROYER** 02205-9  
These large German destroyers were very active during the early campaigns of 1941-42, although they fell easily at the hands of the Royal Navy. A number survived to serve under foreign flags after the war.

### SERIES 3



**HMS 'TIGER'** 03201-4  
This powerful ship is equipped with the latest fully automatic radar-controlled guns and currently operates in an anti-submarine and/or amphibious operations role.



**HMS 'SUFFOLK'** 03201-5  
The Suffolk was in service from 1928 until the end of the Second World War and this 128-part kit comes up into a highly detailed model complete with Walrus aircraft.



**HMS 'DEVONSHIRE'** 03202-3  
The first of the Royal Navy's guided missile destroyers, as large as a巡防艦, she is fitted with a helicopter and the latest underwater detection equipment.



**HMS 'AJAX'** 03204-9  
Won fame for her part in the battle of the River Plate which ended with the German battleship Graf Spee being scuttled. The kit comes complete with a Fairey Sealab seaplane on its folding catapult.


**HMS 'FEARLESS'** 03205-2  
Distinctive by virtue of its offset funnels and helicopter landing area aft, Fearless is one of the Royal Navy's assault ships. Among the 120 parts in the kit are tank landing craft carried inside the hull and operating arm doors.

**HMS 'VICTORIOUS'** 04201-3  
In contrast to the Ark Royal is this kit of the modernised Royal Navy carrier with angled flight deck and mirror landing system. These are reproduced in thicker as are the Sea Hawk, Sea Vixen and Skyraider aircraft which are carried.



**HMS 'HOOD'** 04202-6  
Largest of the British battlecruisers, she was sunk early in the war by the German battleship Bismarck. The 132-part kit builds up into a really authentic 13-in. model.



**HMS 'NELSON'** 04203-9  
Launched in 1925, she served throughout the pre-war and wartime years. The 134-part kit is packed with authentically detailed rotating turrets and all anti-aircraft armament.

**'BISMARCK'**

The sea chase and battle which finally sank this ship was one of the most famous naval actions of the Second World War. The 170 parts of this kit clearly show the power and enormous armament of this German battleship.



**HMS 'WARSPIKE'**

After thirty years service and two world wars, this famous and gallant Warspite was finally scrapped in 1946. The 159-part kit builds up into an impressive and intricately detailed model.



**'SCHARNHORST'**

04206-8

The name was always in the news during the Second World War when she was continually being sought out and attacked by the RAF. The 159 accurately scaled parts of this kit build a 15m model with rotating turrets and elevating guns.



**HMS 'ARK ROYAL'**

04208-4

Famous early wartime aircraft carrier which German propaganda repeatedly reported sunk, she was eventually torpedoed by a U-boat in November 1941 whilst on escort in the Mediterranean. Included in the 171 parts of this kit are Fairey Torpedo and Sverdberg torpedoes, bombs as well as the full armament, and a host of other details.



**'TIRPITZ'**

04209-7

For three years of the war the Tirpitz was a menace to British shipping. Cowardly under attack, she was finally destroyed by RAF Lancasters at the end of 1944.



**'GRAF SPEE'**

04211-0

This 120-part kit builds up into a superb model of the Graf Spee as she was before the battle of the River Plate. Complete with rotating turrets and full deck details.



**HMS 'IRON DUKE'**

04210-7

One of the most famous battleships of the First World War, the Iron Duke was a super-Dreadnought completed in 1914. She served at Jutland and in the post-war Navy, finishing her days as a Depot ship at Scapa Flow in the Second World War.

#### HMS 'BELFAST'

04212-3  
The famous cruiser, now preserved in the Pool of London, is modelled in the kit as she was during her engagement with the German battlecruiser Scharnhorst at the Battle of North Cape. Highly detailed with over 240 parts, this kit even includes the tiny pom-pom mountings and the Walrus seaplane.



### SERIES 5

#### 'MOSKVA'

05202-3  
This helicopter carrier is the Soviet Navy's first attempt at air power at sea and this kit faithfully reproduces the small anti-submarine helicopters with which the ship is equipped.



#### 'PRINZ EUGEN'

05203-2  
A heavy cruiser, 'Prinz Eugen' was launched in 1936 and took part in the sinking of HMS Hood and in the Channel dash with Scharnhorst and Gneisenau. She survived the war to be damaged and finally sunk following the atomic test at Bikini Atoll in 1946.



#### USS 'FORRESTAL'

06201-3  
Sold down in July 1952, the USS Forrestal was the first of America's super carriers and the first ship built specifically to operate jet aircraft. She has four steam turbines and her turbines give her a speed of 33 knots. This giant kit is more than 21in. long and has 200 parts.





### VOSPER M.T.B.

This 6in to 1in scale model superbly reproduces the famous Vosper 73ft M.T.B. armed with 4x 18in. torpedoes, twin Oerlikon and machine guns. The Royal Navy used this type of motor torpedo boat very effectively, to harass enemy shipping in the later stages of the Second World War. They entered service in 1944 and were powered by three V12 Packed engines producing 4,000 b.h.p. supercharged, this gave them a top speed of 38-40 knots. They were fitted with radar and sonar and had a complement of thirteen. This finely detailed kit contains 162 parts.

### GERMAN E-BOAT

Well known for raid-and-run forays against Allied shipping in the English Channel and the North Sea during the Second World War, the famous German E-Boat is now captured in model form with this 1:72nd scale construction kit. 

**REVENGE** 02251-0  
Commanded by Sir Francis Drake, the Revenge won fame at the defeat of the Spanish Armada. Later, under Sir Richard Grenville, she was attacked by three Spanish galleons and, after striking two and crippling two others, was forced to surrender.



**MAYFLOWER** 02253-6  
A small merchant ship, the Mayflower became famous as the ship which carried the Pilgrim Fathers from Plymouth to the New World in 1620. Based upon exhaustive research this highly-detailed kit includes scale figures of crew and colonists.

### PS 'GREAT WESTERN'

This historic paddle-steamer was launched in 1837 and first crossed to America in 1838. This super-detailed model is built from 209 parts and includes vacuum-formed sails used for auxiliary power.

**'ROYAL SOVEREIGN'**

**HMS 'VICTORY'**

**HMS 'PRINCE'**

Designed by Princess Anne, the Prince was launched at Chatham in 1670. In 1672 she played a major part in the defeat of the Dutch at the battle of Solebay. The 160-part kit is based upon one of the oldest surviving Admiralty maps.



**'ST LOUIS'**

09257-1  
This impressive French warship was built by the Dutch in 1620 and was one of five such ships bought by Cardinal Richelieu in an effort to modernise the French Navy. Displacing some 1,200 tons and carrying 60 guns, the St Louis in kit form has 105 parts plus sails, rigging and flags.



**'GOLDEN HIND'**

09258-4  
Famous in history as the first English ship to sail round the world, the Golden Hind became the symbol of English sea power in the 16th century. Commanded by Sir Francis Drake, the 110-ton ship took three years for the voyage and on arrival back at Plymouth it is recorded she was carrying 30 tons of treasure plundered from Spanish Silver ships and galleons.



**'DISCOVERY'**

09255-6  
Now moored on the Thames Embankment, the Discovery won fame as the vessel built for Captain Scott's first Antarctic Expedition of 1901-03. Included in this comprehensive kit are preformed sails and figures of explorers, natives and sledges.



**'WASA'**

09256-8  
Latest in the series of classical historical ships, the Wasa was the most powerful but ill-fated warship of the Swedish Navy in the 17th century. This superbly detailed model is fitted out in the style of the period.

**AMERICAN SOLDIER OF THE REVOLUTION 1776**

(1491-1547) 02601-4

During his reign, which began in 1509, Henry VIII frequently waged war with France and Spain. He led the revolt against the Papacy in England.

### YEOMAN OF THE GUARD

Dating from 1485, this is one of the oldest military corps in the world. Their duties today are mainly associated with Court ceremonies.

### COLDSTREAM GUARDSMAN

02505-5

Raised in 1650, they originally fought for Cromwell in Scotland. The red plume and pairs of sonic buttons distinguished them from other Guards regiments.



### JULIUS CAESAR

(100-44 B.C.) 02604-2

A distinguished political and military figure, leader of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar was murdered by Brutus and his fellow conspirators on 15th March 44 B.C.

### JOAN OF ARC

(1412-31) 02509-6

After her hearing of York she helped in the relief of Orleans in 1429. Subsequently used for espionage and heraldry by the British, she was burned at the stake.

### CHARLES I

(1600-49) 02511-1

Charles succeeded his father in 1625. After financial trouble he dissolved Parliament. In 1642 he instigated the first of two civil wars; in both wars he was defeated by Cromwell.

### RICHARD III

(1457-85) 02509-0

As King, Richard Coeur de Lion (Lion Heart) reigned for only six months in England. Returning from a Crusade, he was captured in Germany and imprisoned for two years.

### LIFEGUARD TRUMPETER

02506-8

Raised in 1660, from Ireland partly with supporters Charles II. Lifeguards, together with the Royal Horse Guards, provide the mounted escort on State occasions.



# HINTS & TIPS FOR BETTER MODELLING....

by Alan Masterman

To get the best from your modelling you need to acquire a basic set of tools and materials. Some of them you will already have, but the others can be obtained quite cheaply at model shops.

Here is the suggested list:

- Craft knife (and a few spare blades).
- Tweezers.

- Small pair of scissors.
- "Rutter" file or emery boards.
- Fine glass paper or 'wet and dry' paper.
- Small 'pin' file (tiny drill - no chuck).

needed as it can be rotated between finger and thumb to drill holes in plastic, for instance to take rigging wires).

Ricot saw (the X-Airfix type or similar). A selection of brushes - the best type you can afford; suggested sizes are 0, 2, 3, 5 and chisel-edged. Art-shops sell good quality brushes.

Brush cleaner (of white spirit).

Polythene cement.

Liquid cement.

Plastic body putty.


**5** Biplanes can be greatly enhanced in appearance by giving them full rigging, using fine Terylene thread. This demands great care, but the end results are superb as can be seen on this model of the Avro 504K. Some kits have rigging holes provided in the wings, but most need to have them drilled out adjacent to the slot-locating slots.



**6** Other models can be similarly detailed to good effect, for example, this chariot from the Ancient Britons set has wire traces and chariot reins added, and the figures have been repositioned.



**7** Paint the model carefully following the details given on the instruction sheet. Where more than one colour is needed, as on the fuselage and wings of the Blenheim, apply the lighter colour first and wait until it is perfectly dry before applying the second colour. Always clean out your brushes carefully and apply paint thinly. It is better to put on two thin coats rather than one thick coat. The picture shows the most usual way of cutting out the transfers but it is even better to cut round the design close up to the edge as this then



**8** Before assembling your model, every part in a 'dry run' first (without cement) to check parts for accurate fit. Any slight flash may need filing or sanding off to make the fit perfect. Here, the propeller of the Airfix Blenheim is being fitted.



**9** When assembling your model, your aim should be to get all joint lines perfectly smooth so that they do not show when the model is painted. 'Wet and dry' or very fine glass papers are suitable for this job. Leave any excess cement that may oozed out until it is perfectly dry, then file away any large amounts and finish off with careful sanding. Emery boards can be used if you do not have a fine file. Any gaps can be filled in with either plastic body putty (sold in model shops) or domestic Polytilla mixed very thick. When dry, once again sand the joint smooth. You can tell a smooth joint by holding it up to



**10** This view shows the uses of plastic body putty (the light areas). It is used here to make a perfectly smooth joint at the wing roots of the Airfix Corsair. It can also be seen as a faint line between the two halves of the fuselage just forward of the tail. The slot for the display stand has also been filled with body putty, a useful tip if you do not wish to display the model on its stand. Seen in this picture also are fine glass paper and a fine 'rat-tail' file.

**11** An Airfix Freedom Fighter with all joints treated as described above. Note also that the tyres are filed slightly flat where they will touch the ground, thus simulating the weight of the aircraft on its tyres. On this model, drop tanks are not being fitted, so the locating lugs have been cut off the pylons.



**12** When you have had some experience it is easy to convert kits to make other allied models. An example is this Savoia Tank being made from the Airfix Mark I tank. Styrene sheet (sold in model shops) is used to make doors which replace the sponsorships, and a lifting job to fit the hull top. It is here seen before final assembly. Conversions of this type are featured every month in AIRFIX MAGAZINE.






**13** Many models can be greatly enhanced by displaying them in a scenic setting. These Airfix Paratroopers are shown attacking a pill-box, the scene being built up quite simply on a small board. Most model shops sell scenic materials - miniature trees, bushes, rocks, imitation grass, etc - allowing this sort of scene to be made. This roadside section would be equally suitable for displaying Airfix model tanks or cars.




**14** Here is an even more ambitious way of displaying models - a complete battlefield built on a larger piece of board. This scenery is made from Mod-Roc, sold in all model shops, which is a plaster-imregnated material that may be shaped and coloured as desired. Similar scenery may be made from papier-mâché or Polytilla-type plaster mixed with sand dust. Miniature trees and bushes may be added as desired.
