THE NAPOLEONIC WARS 1804 - 1815

THE EUROPEAN ALLIES OF FRANCE

The European Allies of France were separate States ruled mainly by Napoleon's relatives. Their armies constituted a large part of the Grande Armee which invaded Russia in 1812. Their uniforms make a striking contrast against the Elue of the French.

THE GRAND DUCHT OF WARSAW

This state was created by Napoleon in 1806-O7. The characteristic headdress of the Polish Armies, called "Czapkas", not only made the soldier distinctive but eventually found its way into most other Armies as the famous Lancer cap.




